Thank you for your interest in joining the West Worthing Tennis and Squash Club. We are always excited to welcome new members and greet returners.

WWC is a members' owned Community Amateur Sports Club which exists to serve the requirements of its members. In doing so the club is committed to providing a top-quality environment that is affordable and attractive to all. The excellent facilities and comprehensive range of sport and social activities are maintained by membership with all surplus revenue being re-invested into the club.

Tennis and squash are the most prominent sports played at the club. Provided by an outstanding team of professional coaches, there are extensive training programs available to all level of players in both sports at discounted rates. Upon joining members receive a 30 minute free coaching session with the opportunity to discuss training programs competition schedules and how to get the most out of the club. High standards of sports played at the club are maintained by our affiliation with the Lawn Tennis Association and England Squash and Racketball; we are also working towards Squash Charter status. In 2008 the club was awarded Tennis Clubmark by the LTA in recognition of achieving excellent standards in the provision of tennis. The combination of affiliations and accreditations helps players gain the most out of the sports they play. For the competitive players WWC fields a number of teams in the Sussex Leagues and has had considerable success both at county and national level. The number of tennis and squash courts at the club enables the club to host tournaments and competitions that attract players from across the south east.

WWC has much more to offer than just racket sports. Bridge, snooker and table tennis clubs meet several times a week competing in their respective competitions but more importantly enjoying the social gathering. The snooker group is registered with local affiliated associations and leagues as is the bridge club with the English Bridge Union. Croquet has been added to the sports at the club and this new section is affiliated to the Croquet Association and will have an active weekly programme of activity. The club is proud to boast a busy diary of social events with Sunday lunches and quiz nights taking place in the bar and bridge room both of which are available for hire for functions.

The club has a range of memberships available depending on the sports and activities you want to participate in. Membership is on a rolling year basis with subscription rates set in October each year for the following year.

Our team is committed to making the club a successful and welcoming Community Amateur Sports Club that is the centre of excellence for both tennis and squash in Worthing. We provide a top-quality environment that is affordable and attractive to everyone, regardless of their age or background.
