# ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries close Wednesday 15 May 2019 at 8pm.
- Full payment for singles and doubles events is payable at the time of entry to secure your place.
- Draws will be posted on the club noticeboard by 18 May
- The competition starts Monday 20 May 2019
- You may enter as many events as you wish, however, should you reach the final in several events, the Finals' Day schedule may not allow for ample rest time between matches.
- Finals' Day is Saturday 7 September 2019.

## COMPETITION FORMAT

- The match format for all events (other than the Men's Singles and Men's Doubles) will be two tie-break sets (tie-break to 7 at 6 games all with two points clear). The third set will be a match tie-break (to 10) with two points clear. Men's Singles and Men's Doubles events will be three tie-break sets (tie-break to 7 at 6 games all with two points clear).
- All players will get at least two matches.
- Players who win their first match will progress in the Main Draw
- Players who lose their first match will be offered a Plate Draw
- Players who lose their second match do not get any further matches
- Where the draw size is too small to offer both Main and Plate draws, players will play a round robin format.

## A FEW RULES.....

Full Competition Rules will be displayed by the Draw Sheet and a copy will be emailed to players. Here is a brief summary of the rules:

- The competition is open to Club Members only.
- Players are responsible for looking at the draw sheet to find out who they are to play and when they need to play by.
- Each round will have 'play-by' date. Play-by dates must be adhered to.
- On completion of a match, scores should be entered on the draw sheet ASAP.
- Matches will be played on outdoor hard courts unless both players/pairs agree otherwise.
- Please ensure you are available on Finals' Day
